

## Kentucky State Aid Refund Policy

When a student officially withdraws, drops out, takes an unapproved leave, is expelled, or otherwise fails to complete the period of enrollment for which he or she was charged during the time that a tuition refund is due, the student is eligible to keep the same percentage of Institutional Financial Aid that they are charged for tuition. When Bellarmine determines that a refund or repayment is due in accordance with its policy, the institution will allocate the refund and repayment to all state aid and grants, before allocating the refund to institutional or private sources of financial assistance. Bellarmine will allocate the refund and repayment in the following descending order of priority, before allocating the refund to institutional or private sources of financial assistance:

- (a) CAP Grant;
- (b) KTG;
- (c) Go Higher Grant;
- (d) Teacher Scholarship;
- (e) Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship (KEES);
- (f) Kentucky Coal County College Completion Scholarship;
- (g) National Guard Tuition Assistance Program;
- (h) Early Childhood Development Scholarship.
