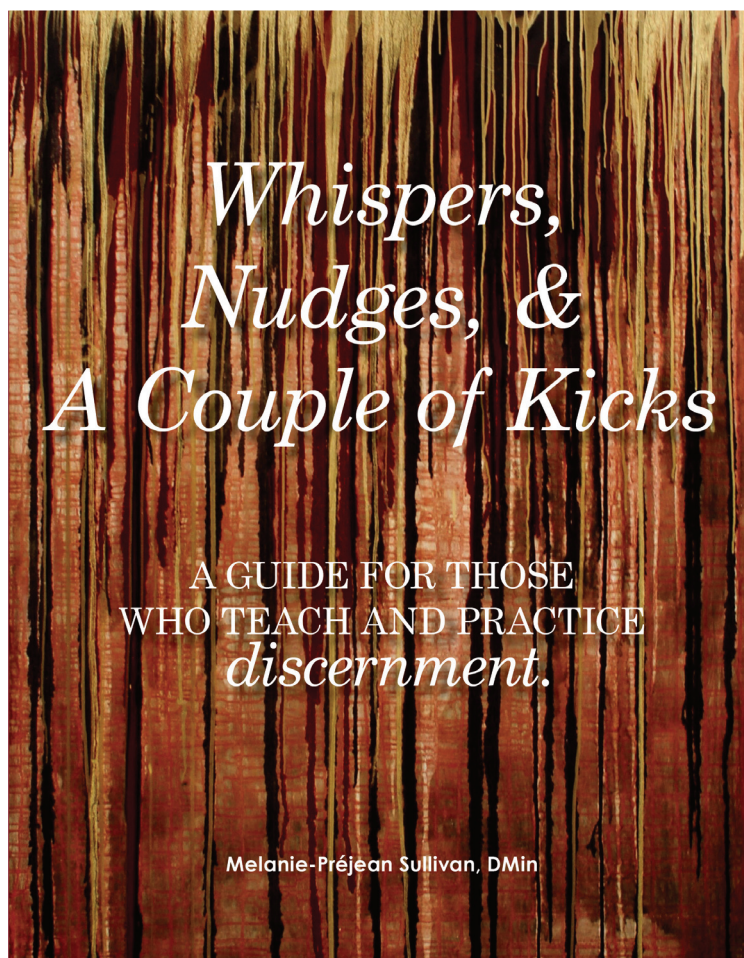


Who am I? Why am I here? What does God expect of me?
