Honors follows the scheduling guidelines below when planning course offerings each term. Students can use this document for planning purposes, but please note that it is a general guide and may be subject to change.

Courses Offered Every Semester

- ENGL 200H - Honors Introduction to Literature
- HIST 120H - Honors Global Perspectives of the Recent Past (2 in fall would be ideal)
- HONR 353H - Jr Research Mentorship
- HONR 450H - Honors Senior Research
- HONR 451H - Honors Senior Thesis
- KNGT 401 / IDC 400 - Senior Seminar -perhaps this should be spring only
- PHIL 101H - Honors Intro to Philosophy (2 in fall would be ideal)
- THEO 200H - Honors Ultimate Questions (2 in fall would be ideal)

Courses Offered in Fall Only

- ENGL 101H - Honors Introduction to Academic Writing
- PSYC 103 – Honors Introductory Psychology
- PHIL Upper-Level Elective (specific course varies)

Courses Offered in Spring Only

- KNGT 102H - Liberal Arts and Sciences in Society (4-5 offerings)
- PS 101 - Honors American Government (we've occasionally offered in fall)
- MATH 205H - Elementary Statistics
- THEO Upper-Level Elective (specific course varies)
- PSYC 218 – Lifespan and Development

Courses Offered Once Per Year as Faculty are Available
