Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma AS and A Level Policy: Bellarmine University will accept AS and A Level exam credit based on the chart below. A maximum of 36 credit hours may be earned through external examinations. To receive credit, official exam scores must be sent directly from Cambridge Assessment International Education to Bellarmine's Registrar's Office. Exam credits are recorded on the Bellarmine transcript as earned credits and do not calculate into the Bellarmine GPA. Awarded exam credits do not count towards "institutional" credits earned at Bellarmine. If a student subsequently takes a course at Bellarmine for which exam credit has been granted, credit will not be awarded for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat.
