DSST Exam Policy: Bellarmine University will accept DSST exam credit based on the chart below. A maximum of 36 credit hours may be earned through external examinations. To receive credit, official exam scores must be sent directly from Prometric to Bellarmine's Registrar's Office. DSST exam credits are recorded on the Bellarmine transcript as earned credits and do not calculate into the Bellarmine GPA. Awarded exam credits do not count towards "institutional" credits earned at Bellarmine. If a student subsequently takes a course at Bellarmine for which DSST credit has been granted, credit will not be awarded for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat.
