International Baccalaureate (IB) Policy: Bellarmine University offers academic credit and some placement to students who earn scores of 5, 6, or 7 on the International Baccalaureate exams. Some Bellarmine programs offer credit for scores of 4 on these exams, however, some exams are only accepted at the Higher Level (HL), not the Standard Level (SL). A maximum of 36 credit hours may be earned through external examinations. This table is a current listing of how credits will transfer. IB exam scores are recorded on the Bellarmine transcript as earned credits and are not calculated into the Bellarmine GPA. IB scores do not count towards "institutional" credits earned at Bellarmine. If a student subsequently takes a course at Bellarmine for which CLEP credit has been granted, credit will not be awarded for that subsequent course; it would be considered a repeat.
